Vasectomy is one of the most effective, and reliable methods of birth control.

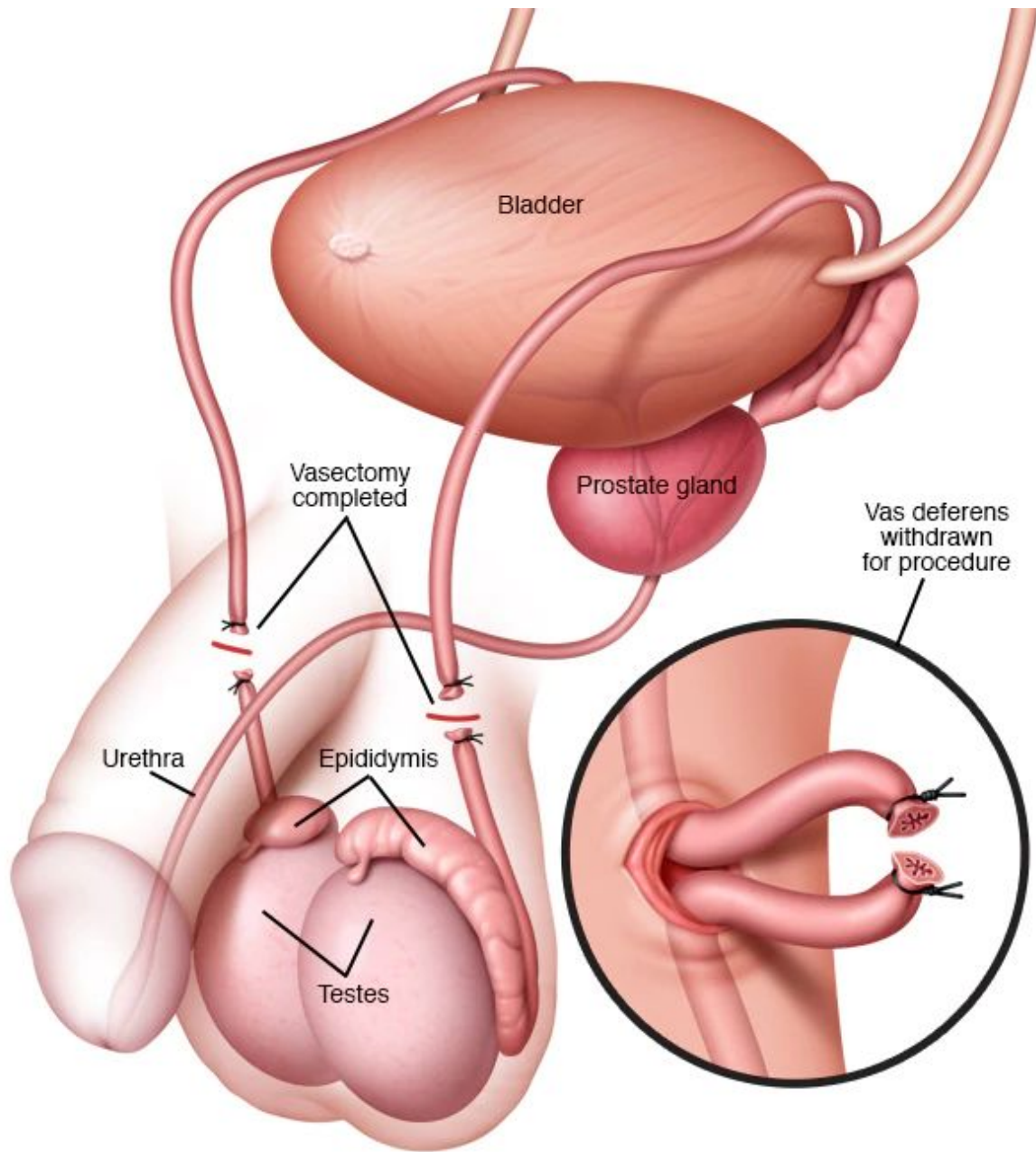
More than 4 million vasectomies are performed worldwide each year. Men are increasingly more willing to accept the responsibility for birth control.

## No Scalpel vasectomy

The no scalpel vasectomy is a method used to bring the vas to the skin with gentle manipulation, stretch the skin open instead of cutting it, tie off the vas deferens, divide it

and return the vas to its normal position in a manner that reduces tissue damage and pain.
